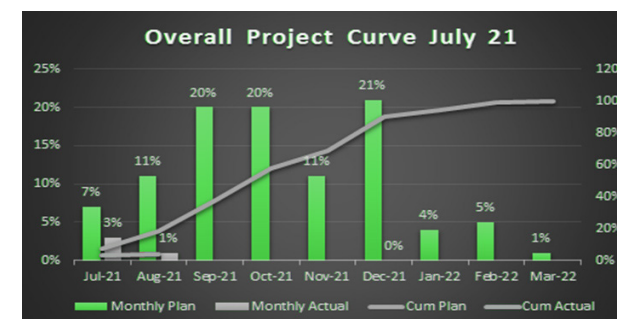

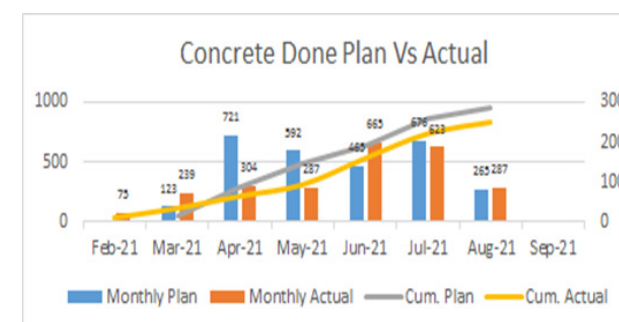
At present the civil construction phase being almost over we are entering the crucial phase of "Erection & Commissioning".

8 % employees are vaccinated with 2 dose

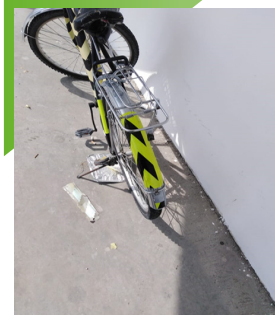

Gate passes will be monitored on monthly basis.

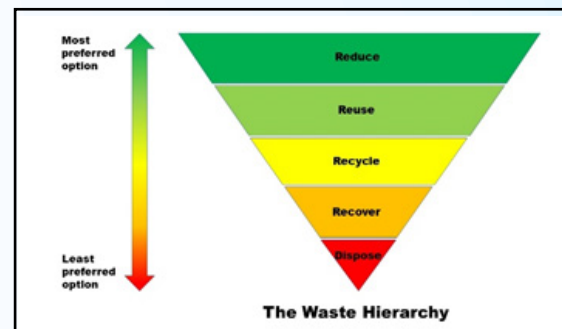
There are no gate passes on Shift "B" and "C" without managers e-mail approvals.

The monthly feature is work at height and steps we can take to control work at height activities:

► Managers

Follow the work at height hierarchy of controls:

- Ensure those working at height are trained and competent
- Work at height is planned and supervised
- Selection of equipment for work
- Provide correct PPE (Fall restraint before fall arrest)
- Emergency plans in place
